

# TREETON PARISH COUNCIL

## TELEVISION LICENCE SCHEME

To be eligible for a contribution towards the Television Licence fee an applicant should be: -

- (i) In the case of a couple the man must be over the age of 65 and under the age of 75 and be the registered tenant or householder. In the case of a woman, widowed, divorced or single be over the age of 60 and under the age of 75 and be the registered tenant or householder.
- (ii) Have no other member of the household normally in employment, either full or part-time, for which payment is received.
- (iii) Not be resident in any accommodation provided by Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council with communal facilities, in respect of which, the Post Office's concessionary licence scheme is applicable.

To apply for inclusion in the Council's scheme, the details overleaf should be completed by the applicant, and the form taken to the Reading Rooms, Front Street, Treeton between the hours of 10.30 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. **on SATURDAY 20<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2010** when payment of the grant will be made.

Should you qualify after the above date; applications will again be considered in **FEBRUARY 2011** for payment in **MARCH 2011**, being the end of the current financial year.
