**The Social History of Maltby
Photographic Exhibition**

Following Maltby Town Councils success with its Photographic History of Maltby, the exhibition was taken to Brundish House on the 15th April 2011.

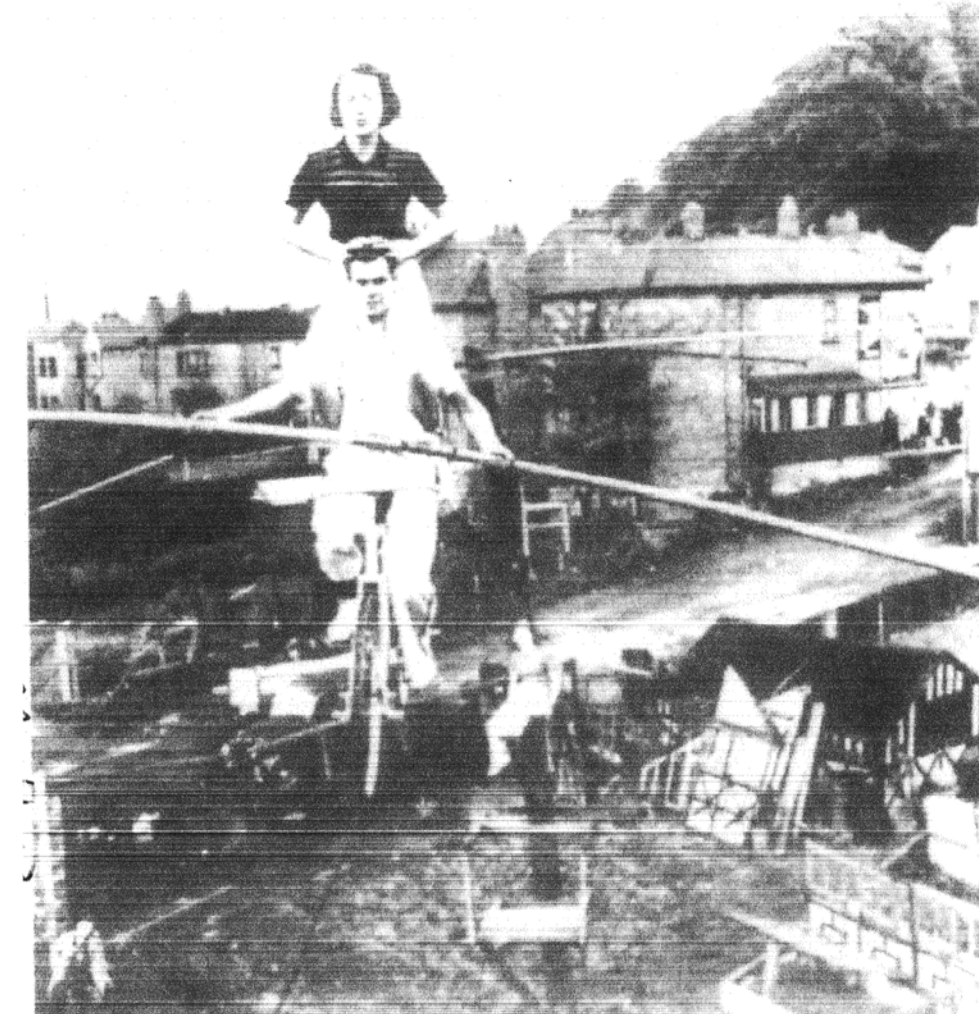
On display were a number of photographs of a family, on Rotherham Road, practicing their high wire act (known as the Great Alanzos?). A resident of Brundish House, pointed to one of the photographs showing a little girl looking up at the act and said that she is that little girl.

In the 1930s and 1940s a family named Davies claimed international fame when they were recognised for their 'High Wire' Circus act. At that time, the family lived on Rotherham Road here in Maltby where they installed their equipment in their garden and used to attract large numbers of spectators when practicing. The family moved to America where they achieved much success and eventually made it on the screen when they appeared on one of America's film epics 'THE GREATEST SHOW ON EARTH'.

That little girl is Mrs Yates who is now in her 80's and she is willing to speak

to anyone who would like to hear her story. If you are interested, please call the Town Council office for Mrs Yates' contact details.
