## Bonfire and Mischief Night

Funded by Maltby Town Council

On Mischief Night and directly following the Maltby Bonfire and Fireworks, the Town Council funded a Bar-be-que and disco in Coronation Park to endeavour to keep anti-social behaviour in the town to a minimum.

The Safer Neighbourhood Team extensively patrolled the Maltby area on foot, pedal cycle and in vehicles, as well as supporting youth workers with the Bar-be-que's in Coronation Park. The activities were well received and attended by a broad range of age groups from the community. The disco, rounding the night off for some of the younger ones.

Comparison figures from the previous year show an overall reduction of 10 incidents and crimes to the previous year, which is an excellent result.

2010:- In this period SYP Recorded 20 Incidents of Antisocial Behaviour and a further 8 incidents resulting in crimes being recorded. These were relating to Criminal damage to buildings or vehicles.

2011:- This period SYP Recorded 16 Incidents of Antisocial Behaviour and a further 2 Incidents resulting in crimes being recorded. These related to damage to motor vehicles. The good news is that one was arrested for one of the damages.

Additionally through funding from various partners (including the Town Council and Area Assembly) other activities were organised throughout this period and again were very well received by everyone.
