

# Theme 7 - Transport

This section was aimed at assessing the level of satisfaction with regards to public transport to and from Brinsworth, and also to collect opinions on such issues as traffic calming measures and parking within the village.

Both the residents and community group representatives thought that public transport in Brinsworth could be improved, citing such problems as buses being late or cancelled, timings and frequency, and young people

particularly, raised the issue of high fares.

The vast majority of respondents indicated the need for traffic calming measures to be installed on Brinsworth Lane, Whitehill Road, Whitehill Lane and Bonet Lane. In addition, parking in the village was considered a major problem, with insufficient spaces in key areas, particularly around the shops on Brinsworth Lane.

## Action

**Brinsworth Parish Council will work in partnership with South Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive and partner agencies to look towards solving the issues raised. It will also seek the support of Rotherham MBC and the police for the introduction of acceptable traffic calming measures and improvements to the parking facilities.**



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# Theme 8 - Parish Council Activities

This section was aimed at obtaining your opinions as to the quality of the services provided by the Parish Council, and the vast majority of respondents thought that the bowling green, the playing fields, the three play areas, the three multi-use games areas, and the two community halls offered a good, or a very good, service.

The areas for improvement were identified as a reduction in the amount of dog fouling, more play equipment at the Millennium Park, and more litter bins on Brinsworth Playing Fields.

## Action

**The Parish Council will continue to maintain the facilities to a high standard, will seek to improve the Millennium Park play area, will provide more litter bins on Brinsworth Playing Fields, and will work with Rotherham MBC to reduce the amount of dog fouling in the park areas.**
