

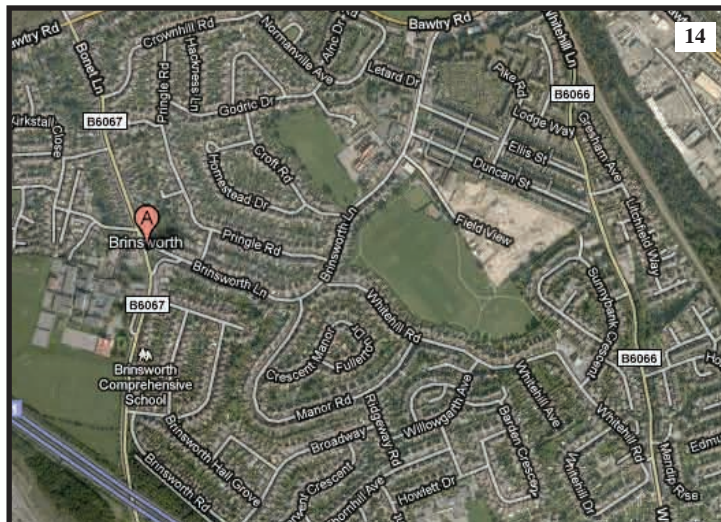
Brinsworth Today

Brinsworth lies approximately 3 miles to the east of Rotherham centre and is essentially suburban with a high percentage of semi-detached houses. The area has strong links with neighbouring Sheffield for employment and shopping. It is neither particularly affluent nor deprived but there are pockets of deprivation in north east Brinsworth.

The 2006 Office for National Statistics mid year estimates state that there were 8,769 people (4,298 males and 4,471 females) living in Brinsworth, which was approximately 3.5% of the total borough population. The age split of the Brinsworth population is shown below:
